Chairman Richman opened the meeting and read the following into the minutes: WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12 and 10:4-13 of the Open Public Meetings Act, the Agency intends to receive legal advice concerning issuance of a final decision on the HMFA #298 Grogan Marineview rent increase matter and NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Members of the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency as follows: 1. A closed session shall be held by the Agency for the purposes set forth above. 2. The discussions undertaken at the closed session will be disclosed when the need for confidentiality no longer exists.

Monsignor Linder moved and Thomas Hunt seconded a motion to enter into Executive Session at 3:36 p.m.

#### HMFA #298 - GROGAN MARINEVIEW - FINAL DECISION

Chairman Richman stated that the Board received from its Deputy Attorney General and reviewed a written form of the Final Agency Decision. He summarized the Board's Final Decision as follows: The Board hereby rejects the Initial Decision insofar as it restores \$328,000 to Marineview's 2005 approved budget to pay down supplemental Agency financing and the parking debt; and the Board hereby approves the Initial Decision insofar as it concludes that the Agency reduced the provision for Marineview's R&R account to \$248,000 in the 2005 budget; and the Board hereby modifies the Initial Decision insofar as it orders that \$592,000 be added to the R&R account and the Board orders that \$174,400 be added thereto, thereby making the allocation to the R&R account for the 2005 budget \$422,400; and the Board hereby rejects the Initial Decision insofar as it orders that the Agency amend the Grogan Marineview reserve schedule to fund the "estimated future cost" of remodeling bathrooms and the Board orders that Marineview comply with applicable Agency procedures, including the requirement of obtaining three bids, and the Board further orders that the Agency cooperate with Marineview to foster compliance with such procedures so as to ensure adequate funding in consecutive future years' budgets to provide for the upgrade of all bathrooms in need of such upgrade; and the Board hereby modifies the Initial Decision insofar as it orders the Agency to recalculate the 2005 rent increase approved for Marineview to incorporate all additional budgeted expenses provided for in the Initial Decision, up to a maximum rent increase of 33 percent, and the Board orders that the Agency recalculate the 2005 rent increase approved for Marineview to incorporate the additional \$174,400 to be added to the R&R account.

Chairman Richman stated that staff will serve the Final Decision and Order upon the parties and the OAL and that the Executive Director or any Chief is authorized to execute any such further documentation as may be required to comply with OAL filing and service requirements.

Michael Steele moved and Monsignor Linder seconded a motion to approve the form of Final Agency Decision in substantially final form.
